University Council on Graduate Study Minutes Tuesday, April 12, 2022 3:00-5:00 p.m. Zoom

The minutes from the March 2022 meeting were approved (29 in favor).

Academic Planning Proposals

Proposal to terminate Educational Supervision, Supervisor of Curriculum and Instruction Certificate in the School of Education

The School of Education proposes to terminate the Educational Supervision, Supervisor of Curriculum and Instruction Certificate. Due to low enrollments in the Certificate program in the last five years the SOE would like to make programmatic changes that reallocate the budget to essential programs that better align with our new mission/vision; thus, a decision was made to terminate the Supervisor of Curriculum and Instruction certificate program. External influences are justifying this program termination as school districts are reallocating their scarce funds, especially in rural areas and small districts, away from school/district supervisors to other essential personnel. This phenomenon requires the SOE to look closely at programs that do not generate income and do not serve the local, regional, and national communities.

A motion was made and seconded to recommend to the Provost that the proposal be approved. Members present voted in favor of recommending approval to the Provost (27 in favor and 1 abstention).

Proposal to establish Practical Business Law Online Graduate Certificate in the School of Law

The School of Law proposes to establish the Practical Business Law Online Graduate Certificate. The Certificate fills an important generalist niche by covering the basic areas of business law that are of the most value to those looking for additional legal education and knowledge, but do not want to seek a JD. This certificate will cover key foundational topics in business law and will enhance each student's ability to problem-solve and communicate effectively orally and in writing. Like other online Law Certificates, the Practical Business Law Online Graduate Certificate will consist of five 8-week long courses taught in order that cover areas such as business and tax law; technology and commercial law; litigation and dispute resolution; regulatory law; and human resources law.

A motion was made and seconded to recommend to the Provost that the proposal be approved. Members present voted unanimously in favor of recommending approval to the Provost (28 in favor).
